

Swim Dock Committee Report

On June 19 Randy Duncan, Roger Smith, Tony Baker and I repaired the swim dock which had been damaged by a falling tree during the winter. Repairs consisted of removing and replacing a section of the floating walkway to the swim dock. All materials and labour were donated. John Johnston supplied the decking. Roger Smith and Randy Duncan supplied timbers and all hardware was supplied by Denman Hardware. Total cost was zero.

Insurance coverage for the swim dock volunteers was in place prior to the job being started, and remains in place for the balance of the year.

A sign supplied and posted by J Thornton is now in place at the swim dock to advise people that they swim at their own risk and reminds them that Graham Lake is a domestic water supply source asking them to use no oils, creams or sunscreens.

Periodic checks by volunteers will be made throughout the summer to ensure that the swim dock remains in good condition.

The Swim Dock Committee maintains a liaison role with the Parks Committee and vice versa. I attended a Parks Committee meeting last week to report on the work done.
