Denman WORKS! - Simon Palmer reported that Jennifer Villard has been busy administering the Community Project Grants and that the deadline for the grants is tomorrow. John Roberts has been working on an Ethanol Plant project proposal. John Andrew has been working on a public meeting, to be held on May 16, to possibly form a Denman Business Association. Denman WORKS! has requested that the Islands Trust look at the Guest Accommodations bylaws with an eye to being friendlier to tourism on the island.

Islands Trust - Laura Busheikin reported that Denman Island has 2/19 of the possible nominations in all of the Trust area for Community Stewardship Awards. There has been a short term suspension on following up on bylaw infractions for 2 specific issues concerning Guest Accommodations: accessory dwellings and cooking facilities.

Ferry Advisory Committee - Dennis Forsyth reported on the last BC Ferries meeting.
